One of the main causes for battery damage is corrosion caused from electrolyte on the surface of the battery. If the electrolyte (acid) stays on the surface it causes electrical shorts, and causes white battery corrosion between the cells. Acid & corrosion on the surface is hazardous to the operator. The build up of corrosion between the cells grows until it puts pressure on the cell walls and eventually destroys it. The corrosion will eventually damage the lift.
